### Prof. Axel Cleeremans

#### BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Axel Cleeremans is a Research Director with the Fonds de la Recherche Scientifique (F.R.S.-FNRS) and a professor of Cognitive Psychology at the Université Libre de Bruxelles, where he heads the Consciousness, Cognition and Computation (CO3) Group and the Center for Research in Cognition & Neurosciences. His research is essentially dedicated to the differences between information processing with and without consciousness, particularly in the domain of learning and memory, and more recently in the domains of perception, social cognition, decision-making, and cognitive control. Cleeremans has acted as president of the European Society for Cognitive Psychology and is a board member of the Association for the Scientific Study of Consciousness. A member of the Royal Academy of Belgium, he is also Field Editor-in-Chief of *Frontiers in Psychology*. In 2015, he was awarded the Ernest-John Solvay F.R.S-FNRS prize for human and social sciences.

#### BRIEF ABSTRACT

Starting from the radical idea that consciousness is something that the brain learns to do rather than a static property associated with some patterns of neural activity and not with others, I explore the links between theory of mind, self-awareness, and perceptual awareness.
